Distance from Dublin, Belfast or Shannon Airports is 120 miles.  
We also have our own helipad - flying time from Dublin Airport  
is 35 minutes.

Galway is 100 miles. Enniskillen and Donegal are 50 miles.

## Accommodation

Cromleach Lodge has a total of 57 rooms – 9 classic family rooms and 48 equally comfortable but of 21<sup>st</sup> century design added since 2007.

These new rooms are designed in three-bedroom suites linked to the hotel by way of fully enclosed walkways.

This *unique* design ensures the ultimate in privacy for all our guests. Some suites are up to 300 meters from the main hotel so that wedding guests can dance the night away while others relax and enjoy the stunning scenery in the peace & quiet of their bedroom balcony. Because the hotel is entirely non-smoking external access is provided from all new rooms.

Our **Economy Rooms** have king-size or twin beds, ensuite bathroom with shower over the bath. All of these rooms exit out onto a covered terrace to facilitate smokers. However, they are on the lower ground floor, rear facing and do not have a view.

Our **Lake View Superior Rooms** are on the ground floor, all are south facing with very fine views over Lough Arrow. Most have under floor heating

Our **Classic Cromleach Rooms** of which we have nine are superior rooms in what was an original part of hotel. These rooms are situated close to the hotel reception and are decorated in classic Cromleach style. All of these rooms are south facing with large windows and great views over Lough Arrow - but do not have balconies.

Our very spacious **Deluxe Rooms** are on the first floor, have private balcony with truly stunning south facing views over Lough Arrow, the Bricklieve Mountains and beyond - and the added comfort of under floor heating. The bathrooms are quite spacious with separate walk-in rainwater showers.

All rooms have LCD TV, Tea making facilities, Iron & Ironing Board & Hairdryer.
